**A CD recording of music by Handel** played by Robert Woolley on the 1766 Thomas Parker organ at Leatherhead Parish Church, will be on sale during the Flower Festival. All proceeds will go to Church funds. Thomas Parker was Handel's favourite organ builder. The Parker organ at Leatherhead was hidden for many years inside a later Victorian organ and only recently rediscovered. It has been restored back to its original condition, exactly as built.
