Flower Festival

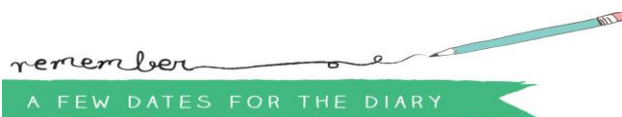

organ at St Nicholas Church, Leatherhead, will be on sale during the Flower Festival. All proceeds will go to Church funds. Thomas Parker was Handel's favourite organ builder. This organ was hidden for many years inside a later Victorian organ, and was only recently rediscovered and restored back to its original condition, exactly as built, with the aid of the Lottery Heritage Fund.
